

13th World Electronics Forum (WEF)

4-8 November 2007, Tel-Aviv – Israel

General

The 13th World Electronics Forum (WEF) meeting will take place in Israel from November 4-8, 2007.

The official WEF meeting will start with a Welcome Dinner on November 4 and end with a Farewell Dinner on the evening of November 7. Our association host, Israel Association of Electronics & Software Industries (IAESI), will offer complimentary tours to all delegates, spouses and families on November 4 to Jerusalem and on November 8 to Haifa and Acre.

Program

At the interim meeting, held during 2007 SINOCES, the program of the meeting was approved and will consist of three main parts:

- 1. Major topics presentations and discussions of leading industry topics.
- 2. Information to enable associations to widen services to their members.
- 3. Presentations of interested associations, including presentations and visits to Israel high-tech industry.

Delegates will absorb all their costs for air travel, hotel accommodation, transfer (airport/hotel) and personal costs, while the host (IAESI) will absorb all ground costs (meetings, venues, lunches and dinners, organized tours etc) for all the delegates, spouses and family members.

As Israel is a famous tourist attraction for its history and for its unique importance to religions (Christianity, Islam, Judaism), the program is combined with special complimentary visits to the most attractive places. A special program was prepared for the spouses and family members.

Venue and Hotels.

The meetings will take place at the Convention Center of **Dan Panorama Hotel**, **Tel-Aviv**. (www.danhotels.com)
